**Postgraduate Program in Reconstructive Dentistry**

The program is designed as a 4-year part time (3 days per week) clinical and scientific program focusing on Oral Implantology, Periodontology and Prosthodontics.

Start of the program will be in September 2010.

The program aims to train the postgraduate student as a "leading dentist" in a multidisciplinary setting in a team of dental professionals.

To achieve this position the student will receive advanced clinical training in oral implantology, periodontology and prosthodontics.

The program will be given against the background of evidence-based dentistry and aims to develop a critical and scientific approach towards the implementation and outcome of clinical treatment strategies. Therefore the student must carry out a research project leading to publication in an international, peer reviewed scientific journal.

The program aims for accreditation by the European Prosthodontic Association (EPA).

Admission requirements

Applicants must have a recognized qualification in dentistry (DOS or equivalent) and should have had a minimum of one year of general dental experience.

Proficiency in written and oral English is mandatory. Dutch is a prerequisite for patient treatment.

The tuition fee is € 20.000 per year for EU students and € 40.000 for students from outside the EU.

Applications must be received not later than March 1st 2010.
